Land — The Society owns more than 140 acres of meadows and woodlands that have been kept in their natural state since 1654 when Capt. George Denison was given the land for service to Connecticut.

Nature — The Society created the Pequotsepos Wildlife Sanctuary in 1945, in honor of Ann Denison Gates’ love of birds and flowers. The land south of the road was leased to the Sanctuary for \$1.00 a year.

DPNC — Denison Pequotsepos Nature Center was formed by Society members in 1971. The \$1.00 a year lease was continued and extends until 2030.

Animals — Enjoy various types of wildlife as you walk the picturesque trails now managed by DPNC.

Farmers — Purchase CT-grown fruits, meat and vegetables at the Denison Farm Market, Sundays, 12-3 PM, from April-November in our lower meadow.

Honey Bees — See our hives and buy some “Denison Honey” at the Farm Market and in our Gift Shop.

Flowers — Enjoy the daffodils each spring on the Homestead Lawn and in our 3 period gardens next to the Manor House. The Mystic Garden Club supports our activities and enjoys use of our barn for storage.

Historical Preservation — The 1717 House Museum and old barn are in need of restoration. Structural engineers have made assessments, but we need funds. Our shingle campaign helped with a new roof.

History — Membership includes free tours of the Homestead. Each of the five main rooms depicts a different period of American history and of the Denison Family who lived in the house during that time.

Community — Enjoy historical re-enactments, school tours, holiday events, workshops, etc.
